COUNTRY	Portugal
VINEYARDS LOCATION	Arruda dos Vinhos, Portugal. Mostly hillside vineyards.
CLIMATE	Mediterranean with a strong Atlantic influence.
SOIL (ORIGIN)	Clay-limestone.
VINIFICATION	Grapes of several varieties with predominance of Merlot and Touriga Nacional produced in the coolest and highest altitude environments. Grapes harvested early in order to maintain all their freshness and aromatic component. Fermentation begins in stainless steel tanks followed by fermentation and aging in used French oak barrels for 6 months, undergoing bâtonnage during the first months. Bottling is performed directly from the barrel.
TASTING NOTES	Very light salmon colored wine, with a very complex with slightly spicy aroma, white chocolate and peach notes. The tasting is very structured and textured, dry with great freshness and minerality.
FOOD PAIRING	Grouper in the oven or poultry meat with vegetables in the oven.
TEMPERATURE	Serve at 10-12°C Alcohol Content 12%vol Total Acidity 6 g/l PH 3,34
WINEMAKER	Filipe Sevinate Pinto
